### FISHING IN OUR LOCAL WATERS —

*A Focus On Inshore Flats Fishing*

*Captain Bucky Goldman*

Captain Bucky is back to teach new and returning students how to catch popular fish such as Snook, Trout, Redfish, Tarpon, and more. This season's workshop will focus on how to use live bait and artificial lures. Everything discussed can be applied to fishing from a boat or kayak, from the land, off a pier, or wading. Topics of discussion will include: knot tying and certain types of live bait rigs; how and where to locate fish (not to be confused with telling you where to go fishing and what's biting); a brief look at tides; rod and reel and line and leader selection; how to properly rig live bait; how to fish and rig artificial soft plastics and hard baits; the Captain's go-to artificial lures; and a quick overview of some of the current rules and regulations. The focus is on inshore fishing, but many of the rigs, lures and live bait rigging can be used offshore. Questions and open discussion will be encouraged.

*Captain Bucky, an USCG licensed and insured guide, owns and operates Bag'em Fishing Charters. A Florida native, he has been fishing the waters of Central Florida for over 25 years, specializing as an inshore fishing guide.*
